

# SEAMLESS FIREWALL MIGRATION EMPOWERS SAN ANTONIO MUSEUM OF ART'S IT TEAMS

## CHALLENGE

San Antonio Museum of Art needed to replace their aging WatchGuard firewall with a modern solution while ensuring minimal disruption to daily operations. The organization was also transitioning away from an MSP and required support for internal IT readiness.

- Existing firewall hardware was outdated and lacked advanced security features
- The customer needed seamless VPN and remote access for internal users
- Internal team required training and support for ongoing management

## SOLUTION

Viyu deployed a Cisco Meraki MX105 appliance with customized configuration, full installation, and day-one support to ensure a smooth transition. Knowledge transfer was included to prepare the internal IT team.

- Reviewed and replicated WatchGuard configuration manually to the Meraki environment
- Configured interfaces, DHCP scopes, and Geo-IP filtering; staged and installed the MX105 on-site
- Conducted live training and provided a recorded knowledge transfer session for future reference

## OUTCOME

The new firewall was successfully deployed ahead of the customer's end-of-month deadline, providing improved security and visibility. The internal team is now equipped to manage the environment independently.

- Firewall cutover was completed with no reported downtime or service disruption
- Enhanced security posture through modern threat protection and filtering
- Empowered IT team with resources and training to manage the solution going forward
